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Silence at the United Nations

We all have within us a center of stillness surrounded by silence Dag Hammarskjöld

There is a long history of working with silence at the United Nations. This is perhaps best illustrated by the small Meditation Room, located in a corner of the public foyer of UN Headquarters in New York. The Room, opened in October 1952, was designed by Secretary-General Hammarskjöld (author of the diary of spiritual writings, *Markings*) who carefully supervised every detail of its creation.

“This house, dedicated to work and debate in the service of peace”, Hammarskjöld wrote, “should have one room dedicated to silence in the outward sense and stillness in the inner sense. It has been the aim to create in this small room a place where the doors may be open to the infinite lands of thought and prayer.”

The UN Charter, in Article 1 of the first Chapter, outlines the Purposes of the organization: maintaining international peace and security; developing friendly relations among nations based on respect for the principle of equal rights and self-determination of peoples; co-operating in solving international economic, social, cultural and humanitarian problems; and, especially important, to be a centre “for harmonizing the actions of nations in the attainment of

these common ends.” Even in the most difficult of times, such as the present, these purposes continue to stir the conscience of people of goodwill around the world. In spite of ‘ups and downs’ in member governments loyalty to these goals, in its 80 year history, the UN has been, and continues to be, the primary space where energy is invested in molding human affairs around universal spiritual principles on a global scale.

It is in the silence that is to be found at the center of stillness at the heart of our being that the purposes, principles and ideals outlined in the Charter can be experienced in their interior depth and livingness. This is significant because truly transformative change flows from the reorientation towards higher values that follows an encounter with this level of Being.

[Speaking to the American Association of the United Nations Association in September 1953,](#)

Hammarskjöld spoke of this reorientation in terms of “influencing the development of the world from within”:

In the classical Chinese collection of poetic philosophy, ascribed to Tao-Tse-Tung, it is said somewhere that whoever wants to grip the world and shape it will fail, because the world is a spiritual thing that cannot be shaped. ... The history of mankind is made by man, but men partly make it blindly. No one can foresee with certainty what will

emerge from the give and take of the forces at work in any age. For that reason history often seems to run its course beyond the reach of any man or nation. We cannot mould the world as masters of a material thing. Columbus did not reach the East Indies. But we can influence the development of the world from within as a spiritual thing

Spiritual Caucus at the UN

The United Nations today has become a space where governments, civil society networks, movements and organisations, professional associations, academics, and business representatives from across the globe meet, to negotiate and plan, and at times to resist, paths towards a more cooperative and just world. There have always been individuals and movements from all these sectors that have seen this path as one of influencing the world from within, as a spiritual being.

The [Spiritual Caucus at the United Nations](#) emerged out of discussions amongst various Non-Governmental Organization representatives wishing to meditate together as a group to serve the spiritual work of the UN. As a caucus of NGO's in formal relationship with the UN, members began to meet for silence as a group in November 2000, originally gathering in meeting rooms at UN Headquarters in New York. On the first and third Thursday of the month, meetings continued up until

COVID times, at or near the UN Headquarters in New York City. Today, participants gather subjectively and online (September - June) on the third Thursday every month for 30 minutes of silence followed by 30 minutes of dialogue, sharing insights and exploring ways to use an inner focus in service of the work of the UN. On the first Thursday of the month, the Spiritual Caucus joins with similar meditation-based groups, gathering in the Meditation Room at UN HQ for shared silence in support of the aims of the UN. All who hold UN security passes are welcome to join for 10 minutes or more for these gatherings in the Meditation Room. For information about joining ZOOM meetings write to:

Unitive Cluster

Many other groupings of organisations and individuals from UN affiliated NGO's now share a spiritual focus in their work to support and serve the UN's mission. These include the [Unitive Cluster](#) which was officially recognised in 2022 as a 'Major Group' of civil society stakeholders actively working at the UN to advance the sustainable development agenda. Centered in an understanding of "the unitive nature of all beings, which is coherent with most religious and spiritual teachings", the Unitive Cluster gives particular attention to "advances in science that confirm the holistic integrity of life on earth." The

Cluster seeks to bring awareness of “the reality of global interdependencies” into its work to accelerate progress on the Sustainable Development Goals. “We recognize that unity is not merely a utopian aspiration: Unity is the existential reality of our interdependent, interlinked world.”

Other Silence Affirming Networks at the UN

Today there are a number of universal spiritually based networks active at the UN, and often drawing on periods of silence, prayer and meditation. In addition to the various networks of Religious and faith-based NGO’s (see the [Committee of Religious NGOs at the United Nations](#)) ; prominent networks include the [NGO Committee on Spirituality, Values and Global Concerns](#) and the [International Day of Yoga Committee at the UN](#). Well known NGO’s that are especially

active at the UN include the [Brahma Kumaris United Nations Office](#), [Findhorn Community at the United Nations](#), [Bahá’í International Community United Nations Offices](#).

One meditation-based initiative, featuring the Great Invocation that appears in every issue of *Many to Many*, is World Goodwill’s [Cycle of Conferences Initiative](#) which invites anyone familiar with an esoteric approach to meditation to visualize seeds of ‘living will energy’ being planted in the heart of thoughtforms under construction at major UN conferences. In November the Cycle group will be working with the Second UN World Summit for Social Development in Doha, November 4 – 6 and the COP30, UN Climate Change Conference, Belém, Brazil, November 10 – 21.

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Breaking the Endless Cycle of War

As members of the human family, we are bound together by the shared heartbeat of our existence. Yet, from the mists of time we have been divided by conflicts over land and resources, ideologies, and legacies. Underlying our incessant wars has been a deeply ingrained mindset which holds that our gains must come at the expense of others. This archaic worldview has shaped our history and continues to fuel current battles, tearing nations and peoples apart and leaving deep scars upon the earth and upon our souls.

Almost the entirety of recorded history revolves around the cycles of war and the conquests that have shaped and reshaped civilizations, borders, and societies. The aftermath of war leaves staggering destruction and loss of life, along with emotional wounds that generations struggle to heal. As brutal as the war itself, the aftermath often brings economic collapse, famine, displaced populations, and social divisions that linger long after the fighting ceases.

Our collective history exposes a pattern of human behavior marked by relentless conflict and

struggle. But there is now encouraging news: many people around the globe are becoming aware of humanity's nobler instincts and higher potentials and they have begun to chart an approach to life that nullifies violence.

The question now facing us collectively is how to learn from the past and break free of the ingrained pattern that has perpetuated endless cycles of war.

Despite the dark chapters that predominate in the story of the human race, the record also reveals the resilience of the human spirit: the capacity to rebuild, to achieve justice, and to forge pathways of understanding.

Humanity stands at a crossroads. We have the power to reject our inheritance of mutual destruction and build, instead, a future based on mutual understanding, respect, and cooperation. This possibility rests on potentials of our species that have been largely untapped until now: an active willingness to listen, a capacity for forgiveness, the aspiration to reach across human divides, and the awareness that no group or nation thrives when others suffer.

can be dissolved by dismantling the age-old paradigm that taught us to fear one another and replacing it with the truth of the essential unity of the human race, a view of life that cultivates compassion and love. A shift in worldviews could be accelerated by teaching ourselves and our children that strength is found not in conquest, but in kindness.

The journey toward genuine peace begins with mutual respect reflected in the way we speak to each other, the way we resolve differences, and our courage to stand for justice without vengeance. Human beings are not born as enemies. In the greater scheme of things, we are neighbours; we are family. By replacing fear with curiosity, division with dialogue, and conflict with collaboration we can begin to pave the way toward a world at peace.

A source of hope for fostering this change in consciousness lies with strong and compassionate leaders. They have the power to influence the way their societies view diversity. By promoting inclusiveness, they can create environments where differences are appreciated rather than feared, where diversity is seen not as a threat but a strength, and where conflict can be resolved in a spirit of truth, justice and reconciliation.

In the case of Syria, the new leadership has held up these qualities as paramount for the rebirth of the country. If the goals enshrined in the new democratic constitution are realized, they will transform the nation, along with its relationship to the region and the world. The stated goal of the new government is to replace a chronic condition of conflict and war with a system of governance that unifies, based on equality, justice, and goodwill toward all groups.

The transformation of Syria from a dictatorship to a nation in pursuit of democracy, in a matter of months, is surely unprecedented in human history.

The global community is watching closely to see how the leadership of Ahmed al-Sharaa evolves and whether his policies will end the centuries of oppression and bloodshed in his country. If the new government succeeds, it will not only serve as a model for post-war reconstruction efforts in other parts of the world, it will bear testimony to the power of inclusiveness, transparency, cooperation, and goodwill to transform a country from a hellscape of war to a haven of peace.

On Our Way To The Promised Land!

It's a beautiful fall day here on the East Coast—sun shining, warmth lingering as we move toward the cooler season. At the same time, we're watching more horrors unfold in California: fires, then torrential rains, flooding, and land being washed away because the very trees that would hold and drink that water have been burned. **What we are living through is not just "random events," but part of a much larger war between dark and light, good and evil, old and new, destruction and creation.** The forces of the old and destructive are doing everything they can—very concretely in our 3D world—to suppress anything that would move us forward: science, renewable technologies, advanced engineering, breakthroughs in health and consciousness. Their aim is not only to halt progress, but to erase our knowledge of how to create, both physically and energetically.

And yet, this is precisely why I titled this deep dive "*On Our Way to the Promised Land*." We made a promise—to ourselves and to all involved in this Earth project—to create a new world, a new Earth, a new way. For that to happen, there must be an ending, a transmuting, a "death" of outdated aspects of ourselves: our psycho-emotional bodies, our patterns of living under the oppression of a very small group of power-holders. Throughout history they've worn many costumes—

kings, emperors, popes, conquerors, generals—but the pattern has been the same: the few oppressing the many.

Now we have the power, knowledge, and possibility to change the game itself—to shift the very pillars of human exploration into a completely new paradigm. This doesn't mean we suddenly become perfect beings, floating in a constant exalted state. *It means we become humans who are no longer choosing and acting from the low, primal, destructive aspects of human nature.* That requires deep alchemical work: transmuting and evolving the lower chakra aspects of our psycho-emotional and physio-energetic being, right down to the DNA. Going to the root, unlatching where these patterns have been fixated in our lives. **As those roots are transformed in the individual, threads are literally pulled from the collective tapestry so the entire pattern can be rewoven into a new picture.**

This old way—the exploration we've been undertaking for the last 10–15,000 years or more—is ending. It is unsustainable. Where there is no growth or change, there is death. This pattern must die, and it *will* die. Everything you do for your own transfiguration and transmutation directly assists the emergence of the new game, the new vision, the new tapestry of Earth. There is a transpersonal line between your personal challenges and the larger evolutionary shift.

We see this clearly in areas that are now being exposed, such as the revelations around Epstein and the attempts in some quarters to normalize what is, at its core, abuse of the young.

Many of us have known the abuse of our young, trusting, needing, expecting selves – the exploitation of our essence and beauty. As we face and transform our own experiences of emotional, physical, mental, energetic, or spiritual abuse, this aspect of human nature can finally end. It can die. It will no longer be required territory for the human species to explore.

At the same time, we are seeing powerful signs of forward movement!

Before recent legislation reopened the government, we were already sensing and witnessing countless ways people were gathering to help one another – sharing food, clothing, household and pet supplies, supporting those whose assistance had been cut off, or who were crushed by rising prices. This echoes an ancient pattern: when there were marauders or oppressive rulers, people would return to the basics – tending their families, land, and local communities. **That is happening again, and it is what must happen for our future ... coming together, feeling for those beyond our immediate circle, recognizing that we are one human family!**

The horrors and pressures of this time are driving us back to our roots, to the core principles of constructive, beautiful human nature so we can fortify and expand them. **We understand that pain points are portals – drivers of creativity, catalysts for the new. As restrictions tighten and freedoms feel curtailed, there is simultaneously more grassroots gathering, more shared ideas, more local involvement.** This is

the deeper purpose behind what looks like sheer destruction: to break down what must end so new blossoming can occur.

We are entering winter, traditionally a time of going inward. Even with the busyness of the holidays, we have an invitation to do things differently – to shift away from materialism as our primary language of love and care, and toward other forms of connection and fulfillment that actually endure. As the days shorten and it gets dark earlier, we can let this seasonal descent draw us back to our foundations: what is truly important, what is vital, what must not die. *Beyond politics, beyond red and blue, we are choosing forward: choosing community, choosing diversity, choosing to care for those who cannot care for themselves – humans and animals, the vulnerable, the elderly. We are on our way to the promised land!*

The World Peace Flame in Ashland Goes Solar



When we act locally, there is a global significance. I encountered the original World Peace Flame Monument in Wales by chance in 2015, the sight of the flame instantly seared into my heart, and I knew I am one with all of humanity, it is the symbol of the celebration of peace, unity, and freedom. I had an unmovable desire to bring the World Peace Flame to the city of Ashland where I reside. Three years later, on September 21, 2018, the International Day of Peace, the World Peace Flame was lit in the Thalden Pavilion, Sustainability Center on the Southern Oregon University (SOU) campus in Ashland, Oregon joining the only other World Peace Flame in

the United States of America in the Civil Rights Museum at the Lorraine Motel in Memphis, Tennessee. SOU is the first and only university in the world to have the iconic World Peace Flame installed on campus.

On May 16, 2017, the Ashland Mayor and City Council proclaimed Ashland as a City of Peace as inspired by the Ashland Culture of Peace Commission. Ashland became the 163rd City of Peace and there are currently 406 International Cities of Peace in six continents in 2024. International Cities of Peace is an association of citizens, governments, and organizations who have by proclamation, resolution, or by citizen advocacy established their communities as official Cities of Peace. The official recognition of Ashland as an International City of Peace provides inspiration for all citizens to create an emerging, evolving, living model for thriving together as fellow humans.

Ashland as a city of peace is known to be innovative and a leader in the global community. We are in a global climate emergency, and we must reduce greenhouse gas emissions while addressing the changes and dangers that the climate is already presenting at global, regional, and local levels. Global leaders are beginning to transition from fossil fuels to renewable energies.

The sun gives life to all lives on earth.

Without the sun, all lives will perish. It is the most powerful unifying energy and light that unites all lives on earth. Recently, as I stood in front of the World Peace Flame at the Thalden Pavilion, feeling the warmth of the sun on my face, knowing every person on earth experiences and relates to this all-life-giving energy. I was inspired to transition the World Peace Flame from burning biomass oil to the light that is powered by the sun to symbolize unity and renewal.

The World Peace Flame in Ashland will be the first World Peace Flame in the world to transition to solar energy, symbolizing peace in sustainability. The solar flame will inspire the local, regional, and global communities to take bold steps to reduce or halt greenhouse gas emissions and embrace this necessary evolution in thinking and action.

Southern Oregon University is committed to climate leadership for higher education. SOU's Climate Action Plan is a high-level plan that establishes its goals and milestones to achieve net zero emissions by 2040. The Ashland Culture of Peace Commission partners with SOU to transition the World Peace Flame from burning biomass oil to being solar-powered, achieving zero emission. We also thank our sponsor Architects of the New Paradigm, a project of RVML Community Resource Center, Ashland, OR.

On April 19, 2024, at 5:30 pm, please join us, and speakers SOU President Rick Bailey and Mayor Tonya Graham, to celebrate Earth Day and observe the first solar-powered World Peace Flame at the Thalden Pavilion to unite all humanity for peace and renewal.
